



Eyeliners

Following the below Pre-Procedural Rules is vital when commencing any cosmetic tattoo treatment. If you do not adhere to these rules, you will not receive the best possible healed results, risk implications, treatments being canceled, or additional costs incurred if you require further touch ups.

KEY CONSIDERATIONS

Please arrive to your appointment with clean, makeup-free eyes.

No eye makeup or false lashes are to be worn on the day of your treatment.

If you wear contact lenses, please bring your glasses, as you will need to wear them for 24 hours following your appointment.

Preparing For Your Appointment

4 WEEKS PRIOR

- **NO** chemical peels or invasive facial treatments.
- **NO** Retin A/Retinol Creams (drug, topical or oral - if topical, not around eyes)
- **NO** Doxycycline, Tetracycline (can cause sunlight photosensitivity).
- Discontinue lash growth serums. This can increase bleeding & sensitivity. Ensure **NO** false lashes are worn to your appointment.

2 WEEKS PRIOR

- **NO** heavy sun exposure to the face - sunburn will increase blood flow & will in turn increase bleeding during your treatment which will cause the cosmetic tattoo to not retain well.
- **NO** botox or cosmetic injectables around eyes.

7 DAYS PRIOR

Please contact your GP before ceasing the use of any medications to discuss.

- **NO** fish oil supplements or Vitamin E.
- **NO** fish oil supplements or Vitamin E around eye area.
- **NO** blood thinners (let us know if you are on any medications you are unsure about). **NO** facials/peels (your skin needs to be in a 'normal state').

24 HOURS PRIOR

To ensure the best results, please avoid the following in the 24 hours prior to your treatment:

- **NO** Alcohol or drugs – these increase bleeding and will affect healed results
- **NO** Caffeine (coffee, tea, energy drinks, pre-workout stimulants) This can cause a lot more sensitivity! Aspirin, Ibuprofen or any blood-thinning medications
- Please also make sure your face is clean and free of fake tan around eyes.

IMPORTANT! PRECAUTIONS

For your safety, we do not perform cosmetic tattooing if any of the following apply:

- You are pregnant
- You are currently undergoing IVF treatment
- You have cancer or are receiving chemotherapy
- You have epilepsy
- You are taking skin medications such as Roaccutane
- If you are breastfeeding, you will need to: Pump & discard ("pump & dump") for 2 full cycles after the procedure, and provide a GP approval letter to bring to your appointment.

Aftercare Information

At your appointment, you will receive a complimentary aftercare kit, thoughtfully curated with the essential products required to support optimal healing and long-term results for your brows.

The healing time for the eyes is approximately **7 days**.

Dont's



- Do not wet your eyes for 7 days.
- Do not apply make up on your eyes for 7 days.
- Avoid sweating for 7 days
- Contact lenses can be worn 24 hours after treatment.

IMPORTANT NOTES ON WHAT IS NORMAL TO EXPECT

There may be slight swelling immediately after the treatment. This is individual and differs between each person. This will go down in 1-3 days.

- Eyeliner will appear thicker immediately after treatment. This will shrink when healing.
- If there is any immediate swelling, this can visually affect the look of the eyeliner. Please be patient while this subsides.

Colour healing is generally a 3-week cycle.

Week 1: They will be darker & sharper than usual.

Week 2: After the top layer has flaked off, it can look quite dull & patchy; even to the point you think the pigment is gone.

Week 3/4: Pigment starts to come back out in the skin, and you will be ready for your touch up.

Please be aware, in some rare cases, clients may require a third touch up appointment, dependent on skin or if aftercare is not followed correctly. This is priced as an additional touch up.
